

# Ten Suggested Approaches to Teaching Indigenous Curriculum

On the website, each approach is illustrated with practical exemplars described in teachers' own words.

### **Preparing the learning environment**

- 1. Make the classroom a safe environment for learning (Understand, anticipate and allay fears)
- 2. Show confidence in your own expertise, credibility and authority

#### In the classroom

- 3. Negotiate emotions in the classroom
- 4. Model dialogue by teaching in pairs/collaboratively
- 5. Get students to question established assumptions and 'facts'

## Learning from experience

- 6. Build relationships with, and connect students to community (Take students to community; Bring community into the classroom)
- 7. Teach students to 'walk in the shoes of others'
- 8. Encourage student self-awareness
  (Help students to know themselves and their own values better;
  Require students to reflect on their own learning)

# Learning and working for the future

- 9. Be open to reflecting, learning and changing as a teacher
- 10. Be enthusiastic, enjoy your teaching, and have fun!
