On the website, each approach is illustrated with practical exemplars described in teachers' own words.

- 1. Make the classroom a safe environment for learning
- 2. Show confidence in your own expertise, credibility and authority
- 3. Set high academic and personal standards (and model them yourself)
- 4. Provide scaffolding and support when needed
- 5. Negotiate emotions in the classroom
- 6. Link your own personal experiences to the topic
- 7. Ask students to relate their personal background to their current learning
- 8. Show students the relevance of learning for future jobs/career
- 9. Be open to reflecting, learning and changing as a teacher
- 10. Be enthusiastic, enjoy your teaching, and have fun!
